Camelidynamics Clinic Mary McGee Bennett October 28th & 29th, 2017 FALA Member Discount

FALA is offering our members an incredible opportunity to attend a Camelidynamics 2-day clinic at a reduced price to FALA members! The clinic will be held at the Moreland farm in Citra, FL on the last weekend in October. The cost of the seminar is \$150 a day, or \$290 for both days if you register by August 28, 2017. If you register after that, the cost will increase to \$170 a day, or \$330 for both days. In addition, FALA members will receive a \$25 rebate for each day attended, to be paid after the seminar. The rebate is limited to 2 members per farm and you must be a FALA member prior to October 28, 2017. RESCUE RUMINATIONS

FALA has once again generously donated \$500.00 to Southeast Llama Rescue. Our organization was hit hard this year with many veterinarian bills which depletes the coffers, as you well know from your own experiences. All male intakes are gelded before they can be adopted. The five males I had gelded at my house were a bargain at \$750.00. Some of our rescues arrive with existing medical needs that need to be treated. At



the minimum, the llamas or alpacas need a fecal test and subsequent de-worming, if necessary. The group of eight alpacas that were surrendered here in FL as part of a cruelty case were in sad shape. Even though they are at a wonderful foster home, one mother and her cria passed away. SELR paid for the burial costs. When you foster, SELR pays for any medical costs for the animal.

When an animal is adopted they go with a halter, lead, and a "Caring for Llamas and Alpacas" book. We have taken in so many alpacas that we ran out of alpaca halters. The word was put out on Facebook and let's just say we have more than enough now!

So, these are a few examples of how your donation is put to work to help camelids not only in Florida, but across the southeast and into northern states. Many thanks to the FALA Board and members!!
