- 4. Entries due on appropriate form, received by October 23, 2018.
- 5. A copy of animal registration or lease must be sent in with registration form.
- 6. Bring your own panels, as you will be working out of your trailer.
- 7. Shearing, bathing must be done prior to arrival.
- 8. Base date for computing the animals' age is the show date November 4, 2018.
- 9. All animals must be owned/leased by the exhibitor by November 1, 2018.
- 10. Exhibitor will receive an armband per llama/alpaca upon entry to fairgrounds.
